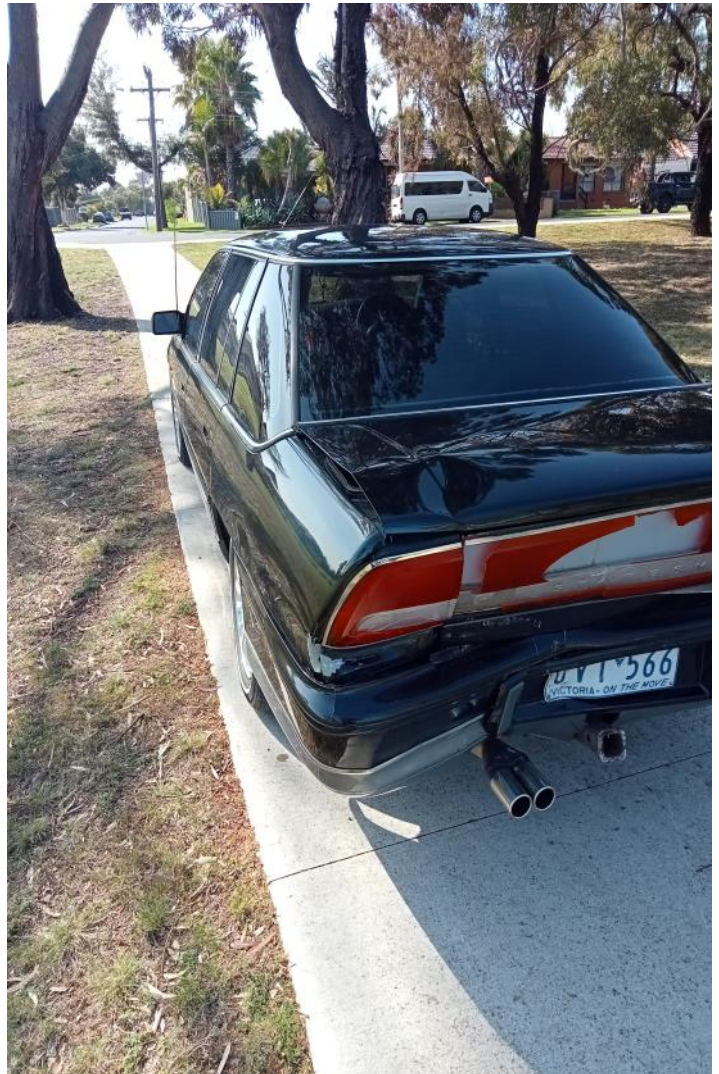

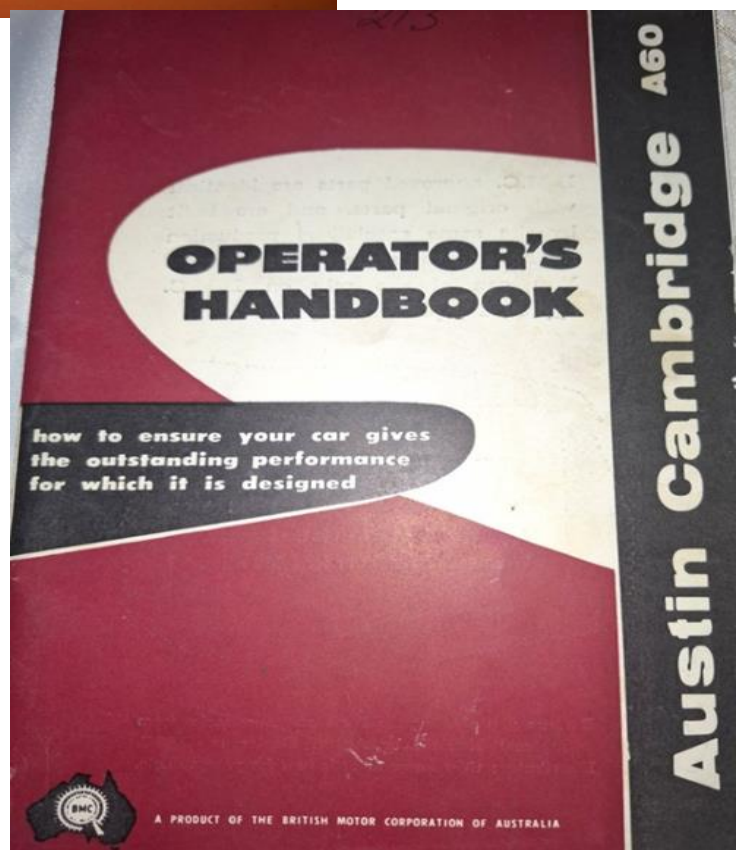
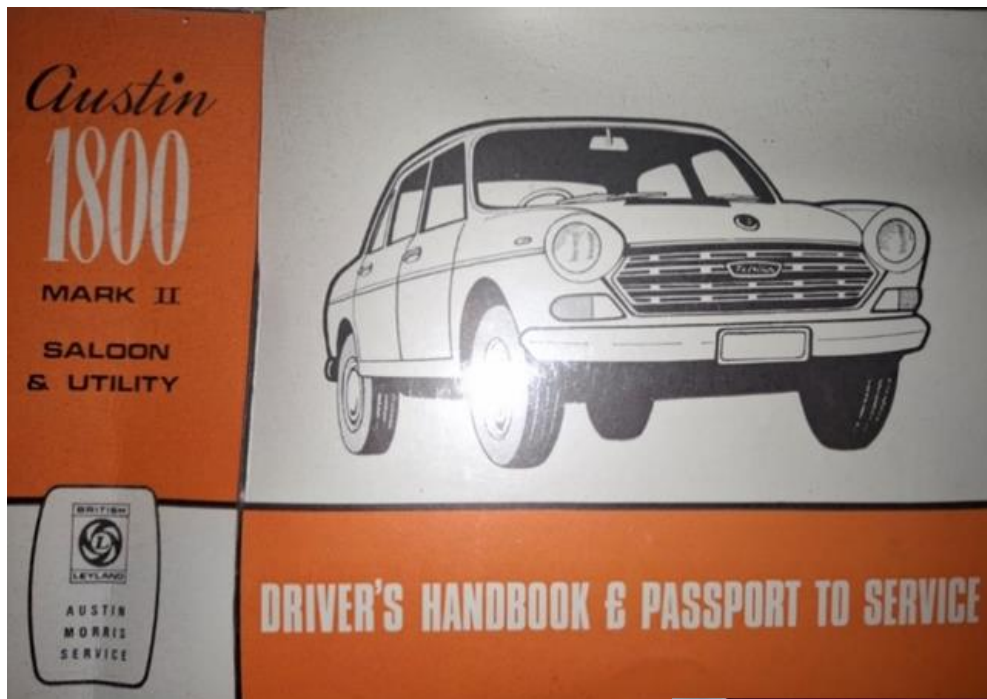

This is a very rare 1959 Phase 3, 4Cylinder 3 speed Automatic Estate. Rescued a couple of years ago by Neil & Tim Fox & purchased by a club member whose health failed & I purchased it from him. Movie Star's Automobiles from the past.

Clark Gable, the legendary Hollywood actor, was known for his love of luxurious and stylish cars. One of the most famous cars associated with him is his 1935 Duesenberg Model JN Convertible Coupe. The Duesenberg brand was synonymous with luxury, performance, and exclusivity, and owning one was a symbol of status and wealth.

Gable's Duesenberg was a Model JN, a more refined and modernized version of the earlier Model J. The JN featured updated styling, including a more streamlined and elegant design.

The car was powered by a 420 cubic inch (6.9-liter) straight-eight engine, producing around 265 horsepower, which was an impressive figure for the time.

The Model JN was known for its high level of craftsmanship and luxurious details, often custom-built to the owner's specifications.

Clark Gable's Duesenberg had a striking two-tone paint job and luxurious interior features.

The car was custom-built by Rollston, a renowned coachbuilder, and included special features such as a disappearing convertible top and a spacious, comfortable interior.

Gable's ownership of this magnificent automobile added to his image as a dashing and sophisticated movie star.

The Duesenberg Model JN was not just a car but a statement piece, representing the height of automotive luxury and performance during the 1930s.

Gable's choice of this car reflected his refined taste and status as one of Hollywood's most iconic figures.
